



## Messaging Application Server 2.0

### Basic Operator Course (BOC)

The Messaging Application Server (MAS) BOC is a practical training course, which familiarises participants with the operation and management of the MAS. Simultaneously the course provides an overview of the MAS capabilities and functional behaviour. Participants learn how to make basic configuration changes and how to check whether the MAS is working properly, identifying problems and performing basic troubleshooting.

#### Objectives

On completion of the course participants will have gained an understanding of the:

- Main elements of the MAS
  - Software/Hardware Architecture
  - Messaging Features
  - IMPS Interface (SOAP)
  - SMSC Interfaces (SMPP, SIGTRAN)
- Operator procedures
  - Starting and Stopping the System
  - Ongoing Configuration
  - Traffic Monitoring and Logging
  - Troubleshooting
  - Interface to Colibria IMPS Server

#### Intended audience

The course is intended for all who need to learn the MAS IMPS-SMS Gateway functionalities, and how it operated and managed.

#### Prerequisites

Participants will need a basic working knowledge of Linux (preferably Red Hat Enterprise Linux), TCP/IP networking, and mobile network technology.
