



Lightweight CMS 2.1

Basic Operator Course (BOC)

The Central Management Station Basic Operator Course is a practical training course, which familiarises participants with the operation and management of the CMS.

The course first provides an overview of the CMS capabilities and functional behaviour. Followed by an explanation of the SNMP protocol. Participants learn then how to make basic configuration changes and how to check whether the CMS is working properly, identifying problems and performing basic troubleshooting.

Duration

1.5 days (9am–5pm, change on request)

Objectives

On completion of the course participants will have gained an understanding of the:

- CMS design, describing operation and interaction with other systems.
- The SNMP protocol, describing SNMP basic structure, messages/commands and operation.
- HP OpenView and HP Network Node Manager are discussed in the way they are implemented on the CMS.
- Configuration and customisation of CMS. Setting up CMS SNMP management of remote nodes.
- CMS collection and monitoring of performance statistics of managed nodes.
- CMS troubleshooting. Dealing with configuration and operational problems.

Intended audience

The course is intended for all who need or want to learn the CMS functionalities and capabilities and how these can be employed, operated and managed.

Prerequisites

Knowledge of Unix at basic system administration level and knowledge about IP networks is required. Knowledge about SNMP, HP Openview and Network Node Manager is handy, but not a prerequisite to follow this course.
